

Mermen Trim Emory, 58-24; Cop Three At Georgia AAU

Florida State mermen scored heavily in two meets over the weekend, including a 58-24 rout of Emory University.

The Seminoles swept nine out of 10 first places to close their second straight undefeated dual season at Emory Friday.

FSU also established two pool records—in the 400-yard freestyle relay and the 200-yard breaststroke—and a school record in the 400-yard freestyle.

Freshman star Granam Techke swam the 400-yard freestyle in 4:36.7, topping Walt Jarline's 1951 school record by three and six-tenths seconds.

At the Georgia AAU Swimming Open Saturday, FSU swimmers copped three firsts. Jim Julian was first in the 100-yard freestyle, John Risher headed the field in the 100-yard backstroke, and Ernie Stock won the 200-yard individual medley. In addition, the FSU team won the 220-yard medley.
