

Florida State's track team had a near perfect night as the Seminoles humbled a strong and very highly-regarded Florida squad 92-53 at University Track Friday night.

"I can't pick out a single individual," said an elated Coach Mike Long following the contest. "Every one of our kids came to win. They all did a fine job."

The Seminoles captured 11 of the meet's 17 events. Three of the events were one-two-three sweeps.

The hero list for the Tribe

reads almost as long as the track roster. John Fuss was the only double winner, leading Seminole sweeps of the 120

third in the same event, one in which the Tribe would have been happy with just a single point.

Joel Garren shook off the effects of a pulled leg muscle to win the 440-yard dash and anchor the Seminoles' meet-record mile relay win.

Ken Misner, in bed most of this week with tonsilitis, came back after a third-place finish in the mile to crack the three-mile meet record by 21.6 seconds with a time of 14:01.3.

Eddie McMillan, who will be a starting cornerback in tonight's Garnet and Gold football game, anchored the Tribe's winning 440-relay team, plus earned second places in the 100 and 220-yard dashes.

In the field events, the Seminoles came up with one surprise after another as they cut into the Gators' strongest areas.

Charlie Galloway, still nursing a leg injury which has plagued him all year, captured the long jump with a jump of 23-8 and placed second in the triple jump.

Jim Buck in the javelin and Bruce McCampbell in the discus both had big wins for the Tribe as the point spread grew.

In addition to Misner's meet record, the Seminoles' mile relay set a new standard with a 3:14.4 clocking.
