The Seminoles captured 11 of the meet's 17 events. Three of the events were one-two-three sweeps.

Ken Misner, in bed most of this week with tonsilitis, came back after a third-place finish in the mile to crack the threemile meet record by 21.6 seconds with a time of 14:01.3.

Eddie McMillan, who will be starting cornerback a in tonight's Garnet and football game, anchored the Tribe's winning 440-relay team, plus earned second places in the 100 and 220-yard dashes.

In the field events, the Seminoles came up with one surprise after another as they cut into the Gators' strongest areas.

Charlie Galloway, still nursing a leg injury which has plagued him all year, captured the long jump with a jump of 23-8 and placed second in the triple jump.

Jim Buck in the javelin and Bruce McCampbell in the discus both had big wins for the Tribe as the point spread grew.

In addition to Misner's meet record, the Seminoles' mile relay set a new standard with a 3:14.4 clocking.
