

Volleyballers Return From NIC Tourney in Nebraska

The Seminole volleyball team returned Monday from a 9-day jaunt in which they competed in two tournaments, the national intercollegiate and the national open.

In the national intercollegiate, the Seminoles placed fifth, being led by UCLA, Earlham, George Williams, and Waseda, in that order. They defeated Iowa State 15-0 and 15-3 to secure this berth.

THE INDIANS fared slightly worse in the national open. The major contestants in the open were pro and semi-pro teams from the west coast. Most of the matches they played were fairly close, however.

Howard Gould made 1st team All-American in the National intercollegiate meet. He set new school records for many areas, breaking the record held last year by team mate Ronald Hambrock of 367 points in 103 games. This year, Gould made 381 points in 78 games. Dick Bagge, with 115 total points this year, made second team All-American.

IRONICALLY ENOUGH, Gould has made more errors this year than his team mates. He erased his last year's mark of 242 errors for a 244 error mark this year. He also erased Hambrock's old mark of 136 total points for a season by racking up 144 points during the past season.

The volleyballers have competed in 5 tournaments this year, placing near the top in all of them. They snared first place in the

state AAU Tourney, second in the Pensacola open, third in the Knoxville and Mid-South open and fifth in the national intercollegiate.

TWO OF THEIR outstanding dual matches this year were with Albany and Columbus, Georgia, both of which they won. Albany was Georgia state champion.
