

Swimmers open with win

The Florida State women's swim team held its first meet of the 1972-3 season and came through with a 55-48 win over Trenton State College at Union pool recently.

Leading throughout most of the meet, FSU finished with 9 pool records and several satisfying individual wins on the part of Tribe swimmers.

Penny Knutsen set a new women's pool record of 1:10.9 in the individual medley. That broke the existing mark by 2.3 seconds set in 1971.

Trenton State of New Jersey

was credited with the other pool record as Delicia Keephart turned in a 30.3 time in the butterfly event.

Starring for the FSU women, however, was Kris Campbell who came through with two individual and one relay win. Knutsen also won two individual firsts, as did Lauri Sturn.

Hitting the road for its next meet, the women swimmers go to Miami on Jan. 20 to compete against the UM Hurricanes and then meet the Gators of Florida in a Jan. 27 match at Gainesville.

The next home meet will be on Feb. 3 when Columbia College of South Carolina comes to Union Pool.
