

Volleyball; FSU wins tournament

The Florida State Women's Intercollegiate Volleyball team took first place honors last weekend at Jacksonville University's Seventh Annual Invitational Volleyball Tournament. Fifteen colleges and universities from all over Florida, Georgia, Tennessee, North and South Carolina participated.

In the semi-finals, FSU defeated Winthrop College of N.C. 16-14, 15-3. Flagler College forced FSU into a three game match in the finals, taking the first game 9-15. However, FSU bounced back with scores of 15-0 and 15-8 to take the title.

According to Dr. Billie Jo Jones, coach of the volleyball team, "Victory over some excellent teams came about because of a well balanced team." Florida State fields one of the shortest teams around with an average height of 5-6.

On November 17-18, the team will travel to the State Volleyball Championships at Florida Southern College.
